


Disposable Snake Trap

Snakes like to live in damp, dark, cool places where food is abundant. Likely places to find snakes include;

- Inside garages, potting, lawn and tool sheds.
- Crawl spaces under houses and voids under pavement.
- Vacated structures like vacation homes, cabins, hunting lodges, boat houses, etc.
- Storage buildings, barns, lean-tos, animal containment.
- Firewood stacked directly on the ground.
- Old lumber, junk piles, well head covers, under pedestal bird baths.
- Gardens and flower beds with heavy mulch.
- Untrimmed shrubs and shrubs growing next to a foundation.
- Un-mowed and un-kept lawns, abandoned lots and fields with tall vegetation.

- Pond and stream banks with abundant debris and trash.
- Cluttered basements and attics with a rodent, bird or bat problem.
- Anywhere snakes and other small pests are a problem.

Rapido offers the indoor and outdoor disposable Snake Traps for the safe and humane capture of snakes, rodents, spiders, lizards and insects. With an all-weather plastic housings and replaceable glue coated catch inserts, these traps can be used almost anywhere.

As long as it is kept out of running or standing water you can place the trap wherever these snakes live. It works indoors and outdoors, rain or shine, 24 hours a day. These traps are available in large and small sizes.

Larger snakes will require the use of the larger snake trap housings and glue inserts.

Trapping snakes:

Our PVC pipe snake trap is design to attract live snakes by help of placing live bait on the glue trap inside the PVC snake trap, it also helps to catch similar size of lizards, desert fish(reptile), rodents, and all other minor crawling pests.

There are no guarantees when it comes to trapping. The best chance of success is to hire a wildlife control professional. Otherwise these traps can be very useful for the effective and safe removal of snakes and other pests. These traps do not attract snakes to a location, they remove them from a location. Trap placement is critical. You must have some idea where the snakes have been sighted or where the

snakes might be hiding. Position the trap in or around these areas so the snake sees the trap as a possible hiding place.

When a snake enters the trap they get entangled in the glue catch inserts. The more they try to get away, the more they get caught up in the glue. To release a captured snake, use vegetable oil to release the snake unharmed.
